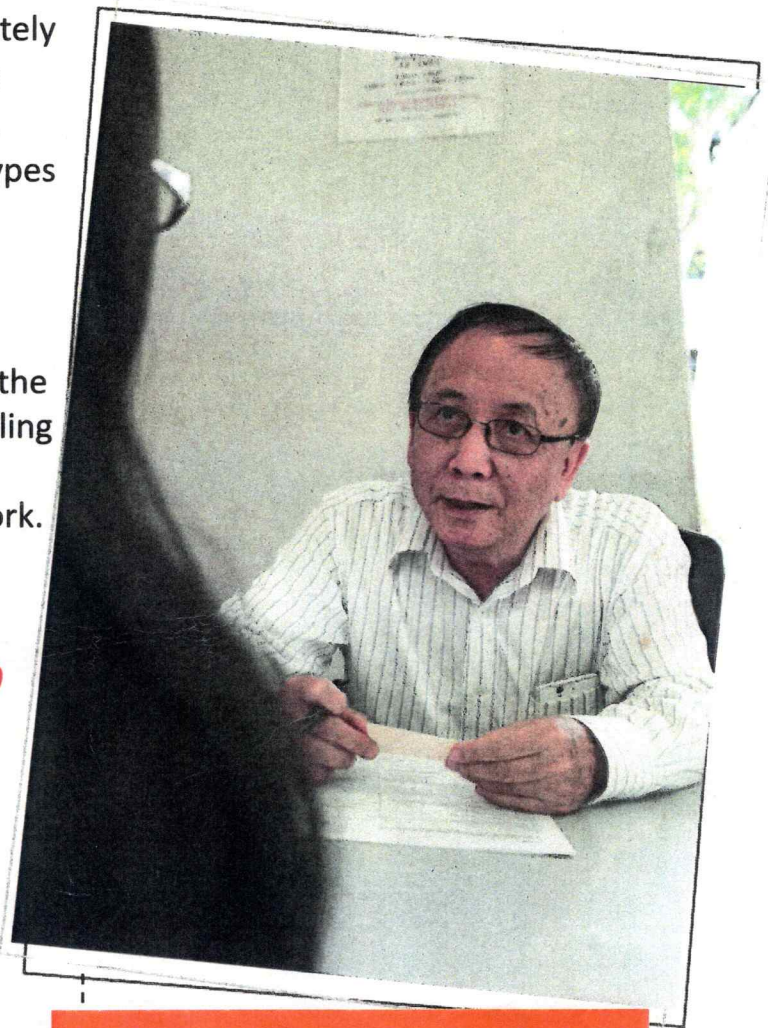
Filling Forms And Hearts

“I'm happy to have found a meaningful job to pass time.”

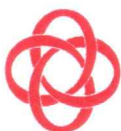
